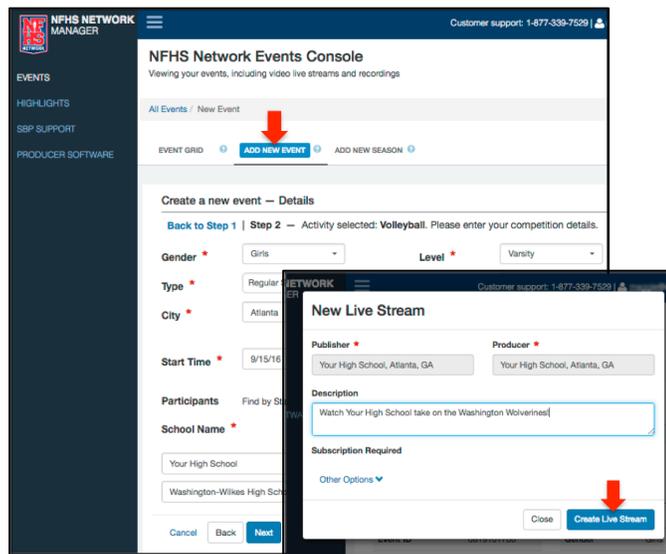


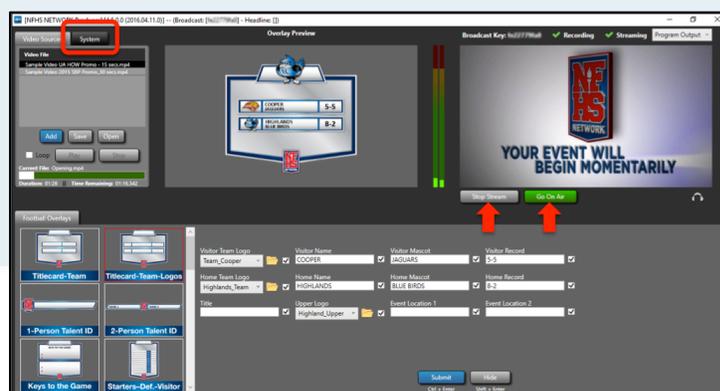
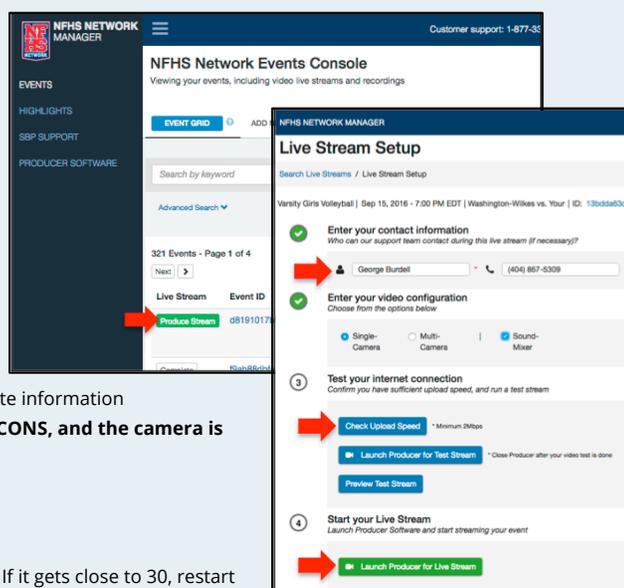
### Event Manager “Console” (console.nfhsnetwork.com):

- Make sure you **have scheduled your broadcast in Console** - to do this:
  - Go to **console.nfhsnetwork.com** and sign in
  - Click on the **Add New Event** tab
  - Select the **Activity**
  - Fill in the appropriate fields including adding the opposing team as a **Participant**
  - Make sure the **DATE** and **TIME** of your broadcast is the actual DATE and TIME you plan to start your production
- Continue scheduling a **Live Stream**
  - If you decide to set a Blackout Date for your event (a period of time that the video will be unavailable), click “Other Options” and make sure to set the Start Date for the day *after* your event streams
  - Note your **Live Stream ID #** - the Production Support team uses this as a reference in case you have trouble with this particular broadcast



### Producer (streaming software):

- Make sure you have **plugged in your video capture device**
- Launch Producer through Console**
  - Fill in the name of the broadcaster and their mobile number (in case our Support Team needs to contact them)
  - Check your **upload speed** (minimum 2 Mbps up for a Live broadcast, otherwise you should broadcast On Demand)
- In the Settings window:
  - Choose the **correct video capture device option**
  - Choose the correct overlay in the **Overlay** drop-down menu
  - Choose the correct **bitrate** (most likely \_846 kbps) in the **Preset** drop-down menu
- In **Producer**:
  - Prepare your Overlays by choosing the correct logos and filling in all the appropriate information
  - Check your preview screen (top right) - make sure there are **NO CAMERA MENU ICONS, and the camera is level, steady, and in focus**
- Start your broadcast:
  - START STREAM** (wait for the Go On Air button to turn green)
  - GO ON AIR**
  - Every 20 minutes or so, check your **Systems** tab to make sure Buffer is close to 0 - If it gets close to 30, restart Producer and choose a lower bitrate in the Settings window
  - When a big play happens (something that you'll want to cut a highlight of later, click over to the Systems tab and write down the Video Time
- End your broadcast:
  - GO OFF AIR** (wait for the Stop Stream button to have white letters)
  - STOP STREAM**
- Exit out of Producer**
- Choose to upload now (if you have time) or let our Support Team auto-upload your event



### Post Production (console.nfhsnetwork.com):

- Sign into **Console**
- Find your **event** and click on the name, then click on the **Video On Demand thumbnail**
  - To clip/edit: click on **Edit Video** tab to access the video editor to clip off bits of video from the beginning or end of your broadcast, and save
  - To create a highlight: click on the **Make Highlight** tab to access the video editor to clip out a highlight (ideally 15- 60 seconds long), name the highlight, and save
